

Windsor Balloon Festival RV Parking: Cabin Loop - Rules & Info

Camp Host Phone: 951-265-7530

In case of an emergency: Call 911 – advise 911 operator you are located at: **Lake Havasu State Park – at the North Entrance on Industrial Blvd – then follow internal road towards the Balloon Festival.** Make sure to tell 911 Operator you are calling from Lake Havasu City, Arizona.

1. Check in Hours: 9am to 5pm. After hours arrivals will be parked just inside the Lake Havasu State Park Entrance Gate, in the designated areas. You will be able to check-in at 9am the following morning with the Camp Host.
2. All State Park Rules are in-force during this event. Please refer to your State Park Handout.
3. Balloon Festival Camping Reservations are valid: Wednesday 01/21/26 thru Sunday 01/25/26 and must leave no later than Monday 01/26/26 by 11:00 am.
4. Quiet Hours are from 10:00 pm to 6 am, Mountain Time. These hours are strictly enforced.
5. Dumpsters are provided for your trash. Please be sure to clean up your campsite.
6. Dogs are permitted and must be leashed. Leashes longer than 6' are prohibited. Clean up after your pet.
Pets are NOT allowed on the "White Sand" Beaches. Be mindful of your pets – Coyotes Live Here!!
NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED AT THE BALLOON FESTIVAL (Exception: Certified Service Dogs)
7. One RV + One vehicle per site. No tent camping. RV's must be fully self-contained.
8. No shooting or firearms, fireworks, or sparklers.
9. Lake Havasu State Park and/or Balloon Festival are not responsible for accidents or lost/stolen items.

Shuttle Service Pickup Locations & Hours

Shuttle service runs to and from Festival about every 30 minutes.

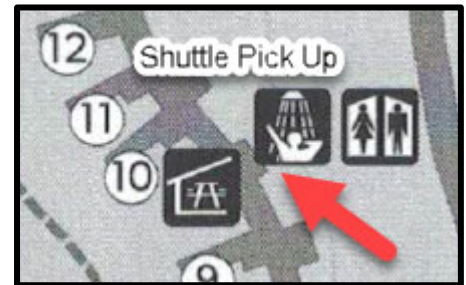
Thursday: Noon until Festival Closing

Cabin Loop

To Festival: Golf cart to Balloon Festival picks up in front of the Cabin Loop Restrooms. (See map to the right)

From Festival Back to Your RV: Golf Cart will pick you up where they dropped you off - at Gate 2.

Propane: Call A&B Propane-Rick 928-486-8027 to schedule delivery to your site. Cash, credit card or ATM accepted.

Non-Mobile Services: Lake Havasu State Park Dump & Water: \$15.00 Dump Ticket may be purchased at the Rangers Station at the Park Entrance. Call 928-855-2784

Campfires & Propane Fire Pits

- Wood burning fires are permitted in State Park provided fire rings. Clean wood only. No pallets with nails. Do not leave you fire unattended. **NO FIRES DURING HIGH WIND CONDITIONS!**
- Propane fire rings and bowls are permitted.

Boating: Launching from Shore in Cabin Loop Area

- Human powered non-motorized vessels are permitted to launch.
- Boats or vessels with motors are not permitted to launch, moor or park on Cabin Loop Beach (Boats/Jet Skis).

Festival Admissions

- Wristband cost is \$20.00 and are good for all 4 days. Kids 10 and under get in free. Additional bands may be purchased at Festival Entrance Gates.
